Teaching will be delivered in an online learning format during years 1 and 2 of your DBA programme. You will engage in online teaching and learning, as well as self-directed study.

There will be an emphasis on active learning, using participative approaches such as interactive workshops, seminars, group work, guest-speaker events, one-to-one supervision (during the thesis stage), and web conferences.

The DBA has been designed to enhance your professional development and enable you to further progress as 'reflective practitioners' within your setting.





ASSESSMENT

Each of the 9 taught modules includes subjectspecific components to evaluate your knowledge and understanding of the module topics. This is achieved through a range of methods and appropriate techniques, including:

- ▶ written coursework
- blog entries and wikis
- ▶ individual presentations
- ▶ self-review
